there will be two Solemn Liturgies. As on Palm Sunday,
there will be no "Crowd" parts exclaimed by the congregation
during the reading of the Passion of the Gospel of St. John.
The Adoration of the Cross will be a congregational moment of silence,
reverencing the Cross in silence & without the procession of venerating the Cross.
