WHAT WE CAN DO NOW

SOCIAL DISTANCING: There is no social distancing in the church but we ask people to be considerate of other people's space. We have removed the red and white taping and moved the church furniture back to where it was originally, which may look a bit strange at first. For anybody who is still anxious about attending church, we encourage you to come either weekday or Saturday morning where there is a guaranteed amount of space.

FACE COVERINGS: These are not compulsory but are strongly suggested especially for larger crowds as they help reinforce people's ease in being with a crowd.

SANITISING: Hand sanitising will still be available as you arrive and leave. Seating and touchpoints will continue to be sanitised.

SING THE PRAISES OF THE LORD: Indoor Congregational singing is also permitted but it is recommended that we do so with a face covering on until a later date when we are advised otherwise.

We do not hand out the hymn books yet as these are considered to be touchpoints that many people share so would need constant sanitising. We promise that a lot of classics and favourites shall be chosen so you can join in.

CHURCH OPENING: The Church shall be open for individual prayer between Monday - Friday 10am - 2pm and Saturday 9.30am - 12pm.

We are also ending the one way system in the Church, so please enter and exit by the main church doors as we always used to before.
