## JESUS CALMS THE STORM



**‘Why are you so frightened? How is it you have no faith?’ (Mark 4:40)**

**WELCOME:** We welcome Rev. Dr. Michael Nazir Ali who will be celebrating 10.00am and 11.30am Mass this Sunday.

**PARKING AT ST FRANCIS CHURCH:** There have recently been a couple of incidents of concern regarding the parking and moving of cars before and after Sunday Masses. These have resulted in a number of complaints and on at least one occasion a report being made to the police.

Please can we remind you that the area immediately next to the church is for the use of the priests, those who are working in the presbytery, and most importantly those with mobility problems and need to be parked close to the church.

You are also reminded that **Week Street is a one-way street**, and is also designated as a pedestrian zone.

**Therefore, unless you really have to park there, please use an alternative parking place and leave spaces for those that really need them. Ultimately, if the problems continue, then we would have no other choice than to close the area in front of the presbytery to cars.**

**EUCHARISTIC EXHIBITION:** St. Augustine's Catholic Church Tunbridge Wells are inviting everybody to see an Exhibition they are showing now until 30<sup>th</sup> June. The Church is open all day. It is part of the acclaimed Exhibition of Blessed Carlo Acutis, one of the more recent Canonised Saints of the Church. A young Italian man, who died 2016 aged 25 and whose objective in life is to strengthen the Faith in the Real Presence. There are leaflets at the back plus a poster on a noticeboard which speak of Eucharistic Miracles.
